

WMF Quality ranking

There will be ranking based on "Ranking of national teams", "The numbers", "Provided Information". Each national association will get points

If any of the member makes less than 34% (34 points from 100), 2 years in a row, it will automatically become the affiliate member.

1. Ranking of national teams (15% of the total Quality ranking):

The associations will be ranked by the official WMF ranking according to the results on WMF WC.

1st-8th place: 100 points,

9th-17th: 75 points,

18th-26th: 50 points,

27 and worse: 25 points.

In case the team don't participate because of any other reason than the WMF qualification, the national association gets 0 points.

2. The numbers (25% of the total Quality ranking):

(Absolut numbers + Relative numbers + Ratio)

a. Absolut numbers of the players:

Less than 1000 players:	3,3 points	
Between 1000 – 5000 players:	6,6 points	
5000 – 10 000 players:	9,9 points	10
10 000 – 30 000 players:	13,2 points	
30 000 – 50 000 players:	16,5 points	
50 000 – 70 000 players:	19,8 points	
70 000 – 90 000 players:	23,1 points	
90 000 – 110 000 more:	26,4 points	
110 000 – 150 000 players:	29,7 points	
150 000 and more:	33,3 points	

b. The relative numbers (annual change of absolute number).

The mini ranking of annual changes of the number of the players will be divided to 10 levels while each level will mean 3,3 points. It means that in case 32 associations in the ranking, 3 worst associations in the ranking will get 3,3 points, the other 3 associations 6,6 points, another 3 associations in the ranking 9,9 points, etc.... best 3 associations with annual change will get 33,3 points.

c. The relative numbers - ratio:

Association members/population of the country.

The mini ranking of relative numbers (*Association members/population of the country*) will be divided to 10 levels while each level will mean 3,3 points. It means that in case 32 associations

in the ranking, 3 worst associations in the ranking will get 3,3 points, the other 3 associations 6,6 points, another 3 associations in the ranking 9,9 points, etc... best 3 associations with annual change will get 33,3 points.

3. **Provided information (60% of the total Quality ranking):**

Each WMF member must provide the necessary information about its association annually and will get points from Development Committee of WMF. If the association will not agree with the points given, they can make an appeal to EC WMF. The DC will send out the easy readable documents to fill in the answers easily.

The provided information from National association shall be the following:

1.1. Make the presentation after the National Championship and send it to DC – the pictures, atmosphere, sponsors, media, etc. – it is important to see, how the National Championship is organized in all countries and what is the progress in developing countries. This will be a motivation factor for members to not „just organize“ National Championship, but to organize it on best possible level and promote minifootball even more. **(20 possible points)**

1.2. Send the annual report of the member association until the end of October each year (for the period July 1st – June 30th next year).

This report will include:

1.2.1. Number of active players.

1.2.2. Number of active teams.

1.2.4. National minifootball website: Link, Number of "Unique Visitors" and "Page views" (via print screen).

1.2.5. National minifootball Facebook page: Link and number of "Likes"

1.2.6. Information about "talks with the Ministry" – if there is no communication what are the requirements of the Ministry regarding minifootball recognition and financial support as well.

1.2.7. Development – milestones for the next year.

1.2.8. What is working well in each member association in order other members can implement this as well.

1.2.9. Provide the list national media partners with following information: the name, link to website, how often is publicized, the readability (how many people it reaches) and what kind of media it is: print/online/TV, etc.

1.2.10. How was the national team chosen.

1.2.11. Provide the names of the sponsors of the National Association with following information: Is it the financial help or barter? What is the interest of the partner (to promote the brand, sales support, PR, etc.)?

1.2.12. To send the presentation for partners (WMF will create methodical instructions for presentation). **20 points**

1.3. Follow the Regulation for the National team roster:

- 1.3.1. Must be sent 30 days prior to WMF WC.
- 1.3.2. Until 3 days prior to WMF WC, max. 5 players can be changed.
- 1.3.4. Max. 5 players from one team. **5 points**

1.4. Cooperate with Mass media // mass media coverage of national championship and national team of each members.

1.4.1. National Championship and National Team in WMF WC should be promoted (make an agreement if possible) through at least one NATIONAL mass media (newspaper, national sport web portal, TV, etc.).

1.4.2. At least one article in Regional newspaper is a must regarding National Championship. **15 points**

1.5. Follow the anti-doping rules, regulations and policies by the World Anti-Doping Agency (**5 points**)

1.6. Collect data about players (YES or NOT):

- 1.6.1. Name and surname
- 1.6.2. Date of Birth

- 1.6.4. ID number
- 1.6.5. Sex

1.7. Financial obligations: membership fee, participations fee, etc. (**15 points**)
